

Deepening Democracy: From Representation to Participation

"Currently, <u>we are witnessing a "power shift" in public governance</u>. Authority is being redistributed among states, markets, citizens and civil society.

There are now <u>stronger pressures to increase</u> the quality of communication, consultation and <u>participation</u> in policy formulation.

<u>Representative democracy does not necessarily easily lend itself to</u> <u>such changes</u>, and most governments are struggling to come to terms with this issue."








The city of Bangalore has a total annual budget of about Rs 1,000 crores

BMP Budget: 2001-02



- Only item <u>determined in a</u> <u>decentralised</u> <u>manner</u>, in each ward, by the Elected Representative
- Citizens' Voice brought into an area of <u>immediate local</u> <u>consequence</u>: roads, drains, footpaths

The old way: patronage with analog data




Citizens get emasculated when they are systematically kept out of the information loop

The new way: partnership with digital data








